During Transportation Week, we focus on a different subject each day: trains, construction vehicles, racecars, firetrucks, and rockets. Our Campers will shoot off stomp rockets, race cardboard box trains, and haul rocks in their dump trucks.

Each day, our campers have an Adventure about the day's topic. During the Ridin' the Railroad Adventure, for instance, children explore different aspects of trains, including, what they are used for, the sounds they make, and how fast they can travel. The emphasis of this Adventure is social studies. Children learn about changes in transportation leading up to the invention of the train.
